### **Resource Sharing & MOU – Background**

• Workforce Investment Act of 1998 (WIA) Requirement

- Entities responsible for the administration of separate Federal workforce investment, educational, and other human resource programs and funding streams (referred to as One-Stop partners) are to collaborate to create a seamless delivery system that will enhance access to services and improve employment outcomes for individuals receiving services.
- The WIA specifies that the required One-Stop partners include programs funded by the Department of Labor (<u>Title I of WIA, Wagner-Peyser, Unemployment</u> <u>Insurance, Trade Adjustment Assistance, NAFTA Transitional Adjustment</u> <u>Assistance, Welfare-to-Work, Senior Community Service Employment, and</u> <u>Veterans Workforce Investment programs and activities under 38 U.S.C. Chapter</u> <u>41), Education (Vocational Rehabilitation, Adult Education, and Postsecondary</u> <u>Vocational Education), Health and Human Services (Employment and Training</u> <u>activities under the Community Services Block Grant) and Housing and Urban</u> <u>Development (Employment and Training activities), and authorizes any other</u> <u>appropriate program to serve as a partner, including the Temporary Assistance to</u> <u>Needy Families and the Food Stamp Employment and Training and Work programs.</u>



# **One Stop Partner's Responsibility**

- 1. Making available to participants the core services that are applicable to their programs;
- 2. Using a portion of their funds to create and maintain the One-Stop system and to provide applicable core services;
- 3. Entering into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Local Workforce Investment Board (Local Board) regarding the operation of the One-Stop system;
- 4. Participating in the operation of the One-Stop system in a manner consistent with the MOU and the partner's authorizing law; and
- 5. Providing representation on the Local Board.





#### **Next Steps**

- All mandated partners will be asked to participate in a meeting to discuss developing Resource Sharing Agreements and Memorandum of Understanding.
- The meeting will be scheduled for the first week of May.
- Separate meetings will be held with each partner to discuss how they contribute to the One Stop Career Link System.
- Resource Sharing Agreements and Memorandums of Understanding will be drafted, and signed by all partners.
