

## San Francisco Local Homeless Coordinating Board

**Background:** In the consolidated Continuum of Care (CoC) grants application to HUD we set annual action steps to meet HUD objectives (e.g. create new permanent housing, keep homeless persons in permanent housing over 6 months, etc.). In order to carry out those action steps, LHCB staff have developed a quarterly implementation schedule, which will be presented for review at the November 7, 2011 Local Board meeting. At that time, the Local Board will consider the relative priority of action steps, when during the next year they should be implemented, and what specific activities should be undertaken to achieve the action step and, ultimately, the HUD objective.
