Welcome of New WiCAC Member Marcy Orosco (Discussion Item)	Sheryl Davis, acting Co-Facilitator, introduced Marcy Orosco representing the Local Homeless Coordinating Board (LHCB) as the new member to the WiCAC replacing Phil Clark. Ms. Orosco gave a brief introduction of herself. WiCAC members introduced themselves and the organizations they represent to new member Marcy Orosco.	
Selection of WiCAC Co-Facilitator(s) (Action Item)	Prior to selection of the new co-facilitators, Sheryl Davis announced her verbal resignation to the members of WiCAC, moving forward to put on motion to elect new Acting Co-Facilitator(s) to replace former Acting Co-Facilitator Phil Clark and Ms. Davis herself. A brief introduction of Acting Co-Facilitator roles and responsibilities were provided by Ms. Davis and Greg Asay, OEWD Liaison to the WiCAC. Doug Parish, volunteered to be one of two acting co-facilitators, action was motioned by Macio Lyons and seconded by Winnie Yu, vote passed unanimously by members. Acting Co-Facilitator Marcy Orosco was nominated by Winnie Yu and seconded by Macio Lyons. Nomination was accepted by Marcy Orosco, and vote passed unanimously by members.

<p>OEWD Staff Update on Workforce RFP (Discussion Item)</p>	<p>Greg Asay of OEWD discussed a PowerPoint presentation showing the breakdown of OEWD Request For Proposals 113 funding sources: Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Workforce Investment Act (WIA), and the General Fund. David Taylor, Workforce Development Specialist, OEWD, announced that the Citizen's Committee on Community Development will hold a public hearing to discuss RFP 113 on Tuesday, March 26, 2013 at 5pm. The hearing will be held at One South Van Ness Avenue, 2nd Floor.</p>
<p>Report Out from WiCAC Members Representing: Local Homeless Coordinating Board (LHCB), Reentry Council and TAY-SF (Discussion Item)</p>	<p>Macio Lyons, liaison to the Reentry Council, stated that there was a discussion at the December 4th, 2012 meeting regarding the Reentry Council's vision of re-alignment and funding. There was no report from Local Homeless Coordinating Board or from TAY-SF.</p>
<p>WiCAC Report to the WISF at March 27th Meeting (Discussion Item)</p>	<p>Acting Co-Facilitator, Marcy Orosco volunteered to replace Sheryl Davis as a representative of the WiCAC at the next WISF meeting. Committee members expressed interest in a possible meeting with WISF Chair Rob Black prior to the upcoming WISF meeting.</p>
