Adoption of the Agenda (Action

Approve WiCAC Meeting Minutes from September 13, 2013

Presentation on the San Francisco CBO Workforce Coalition (Discussion and Possible Action Item) Presentation given by Liz Jackson-Simpson, who stated that the CBO Workforce Coalition is still in its formation stage. It is looking at a variety of issues, including:

- \*How to support and assist the workforce system;
- \*Look at the basic skill level (both hard and soft skills) of those applying, such as those reentering from the jail system or homelessness;
- \*Workplace competencies;
- \*How to better support and align resources;
- \*Explore collaboration of volunteer time;
- \*Locate funding for collaborating.

OEWD Updates (Discussion and Possible Action Item)

Greg Asay, OEWD liaison to the WiCAC, reported on the status of San Francisco's Local Plan submittal to the California Workforce Investment Board. While the plan was well received, the California WIB expressed concern regarding San Francisco's performance with WIA youth common measures. The City is working to make improvements to those outcomes. Greg Asay also reported on a recent Budget & Legislative Analyst report on the City's workforce system, noting that the report recommended deleting unworkable provisions of the administrative code and instead creating an inter-departmental body to coordinate City workforce investments.
