Commissions, boards, councils and other agencies of the City and County exist to conduct the people's business. This ordinance assures that deliberations are conducted before the people and that City operations are open to the people's review. Late requests will be honored if possible. Requests for language interpreters at a meeting must be received at least 72 hours in advance of the meeting to help ensure availability.
