- 7) What would you like to be notified about through email?
- 8) What suggestions do you have, if any, for a new meeting location?



# Summary of Overall Satisfaction

1. As a board member, 62% of you agree your voice is heard and valued, and 53% feel the experience of being a board member is rewarding.
2. 54% feel that the meeting time is well spent, and 69% feel that the reports and presentations are clear and contain needed information.
3. 15% feel that the room is not conducive to work, but others like that it is conveniently located.
4. 69% feel prepared to discuss materials sent in advance.
