LEGISLATIVE UPDATES – MARCH 2015

- Extend the legislative review period an additional 24 months, from March 25, 2015 – March 24, 2017
- Hold the mandatory local hiring requirement at 30% until March 24, 2017. Local apprenticeship requirement remains at 50%

LOCAL HIRING ON FEDERAL CONTRACTS ADDITIONAL UPDATES — MARCH 2015

- U.S. Department of Transportation (USDOT) amends regulation to allow geographic-based hiring preferences on projects funded by the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and Federal Transit Administration (FTA).
- The one year pilot program was effective February 24, 2015.
 Program outcomes will be evaluated to determine further guidance.
- OEWD is working with the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA) to incorporate local hiring language on federally funded projects.
