The San Francisco Substandard Income for WIOA Eligibility has been revised effective July 1, 2015.

**INCOME CRITERIA FOR SAN FRANCISCO**

2	\$9,265
3	\$12,716
4	\$15,698
5	\$18,525
6	\$21,666 *

The “San Francisco Substandard Income Criteria” reflect, for each size of family, the larger of two federally specified income criteria. These two criteria are the “Official (Nationwide Urban) Poverty Level” computed, revised, and published annually by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) in the Federal Register on January 22, 2015 and the 2015 seventy percent of the “Lower Living Standard Income Level” (LLSIL) for the San Francisco Metropolitan Statistical Area computed, revised, and published by the Secretary of Labor in the Federal Register on March 27, 2015.

Maximum income amount for each size of family for the period (6 months) immediately preceding the date of application which is applicable for purposes of determining eligibility for WIOA Title I programs.

\*. Add \$2,080 for each additional family member over 6.
