Local Hiring Policy Amendment

Local Hiring Requirement at 30%

 Recommended permanent hold at 30% by Mayor's Construction Workforce Advisory Committee on November 29, 2016

Ordinance cosponsored by Supervisor Fewer

- Amend
 Administrative Code
 to move policy from
 Chapter 6 to
 Chapter 82
- Set mandatory participation levels for project work hours at 30% permanently

Amendment approved by Budget & Finance Committee

- Amendment approved on March 2, 2017
- Moves to full Board of Supervisors on March 14, 2017

Annual Form 700 Filing - Deadline: April 3, 2017

Statements of Economic Interests (Form 700):

Public Officials and Designated Employees required to file annually

Purpose:

- Monitor financial interests to detect and avoid potential conflicts of interest
- Transparency and public confidence that governmental decisions are made without personal financial gain

Late Fees:

• Late filings are subject to fees of \$10/day, up to a maximum of \$100
