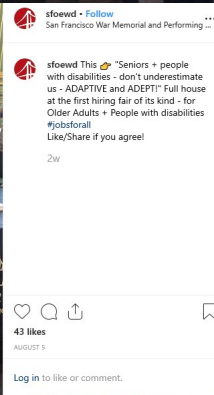

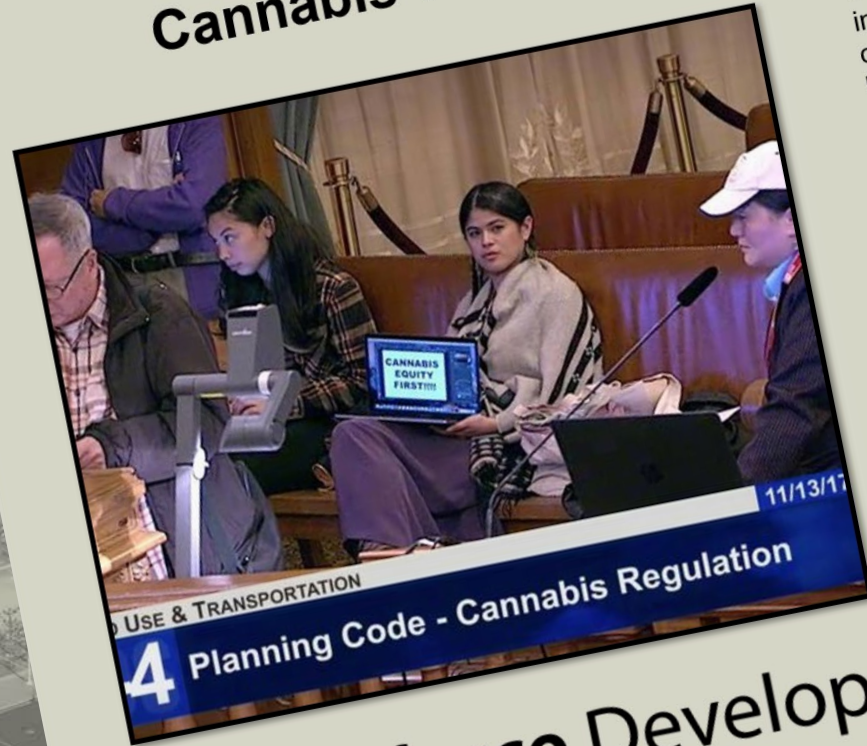
Cannabis Workforce Development Policies

We have several Cannabis Workforce Development Policies:

- 1) Labor Peace Agreement (SF Police Code section 1609(b)(12))
- 2) First Source Hiring (SF Police Code section 1618(g))
- 3) Local Hiring (SF Police Code section 161)
- 4) Cannabis Apprenticeship Ordinance, aka "CityGrow" (SF Police Code section 1618)

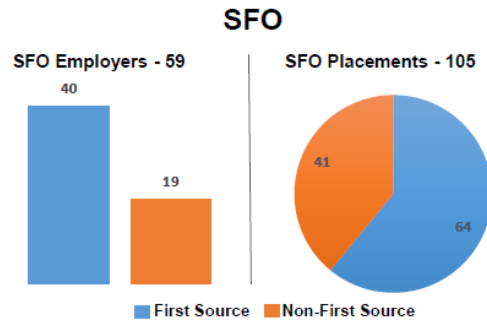
