Frequently asked questions

How can we start the process of getting our first apprentice?

Contact one of our representatives below. You can hire on an apprentice at any time. We'll walk you through how this works, help determine which positions add the most value to your company, and answer any questions along the way.

How long does an apprenticeship last?

The typical apprenticeship lasts 6-12 months depending on a company's need and training schedule (we also measure this with the help of the mentor your organization assigns).

How much should we budget for an apprentice?

Typically, a company will pay an apprentice 60% of the average salary for an entry-level equivalent of the role. TechSF also provides up to \$5,000 to you for each new apprentice to offset the cost of mentoring, training or other administrative expenses.

What is the cost of training?

TechSF covers the training at no-cost through our partnerships with Galvanize, General Assembly, BAVC, City College of San Francisco and many others. We also offer LinkedIn Learning accounts to all apprentices.

Do I need to provide any training or mentoring?

Educational training is offered through TechSF, but the apprentice receives on-the-job training through you. TechSF helps you set this up along with identifying an internal mentor and curating a comprehensive learning plan through our training partners. Specific trainings vary by role.
