Home Health Aide/Caregiver Orientation (English/Chinese)

Learn about working as a home health aide, training class content, schedule, and the certification and job search process after completion of training.

Hospitality Initiative – Custodial/Culinary Orientation (English/Chinese)

Orientation provides introduction to hospitality industry, information on sub-sectors, career pathways and occupations, and services offered through this initiative.

Interview Preparation Workshop (English/Chinese)

Job Search Skills Workshop (English/Chinese)

Learn what it takes to job search successfully and effectively by conducting targeted job search in growing industries.

Master Application Workshop (English/Chinese)

Learn how to complete a standard application for employment. Please bring a detailed employment history or resume, and a list of professional and personal references.

Mock Interview Practice Workshop (English)

Learn and practice interviewing skills through role-play, mock interview, and other interactive group activities.

NAP Services Orientation (English/Chinese)

Learn about services offered at the Chinatown NAP Career Link Center, and other programs offered to the public.

Resume Basics Workshop (English/Chinese)

Learn resume basics and how to create or update your resume. Please bring a detailed employment history or resume. Completion of Master Application workshop recommended.

SCSEP (for persons aged 55 and older) Orientation (English/Chinese)

Senior Community Service Employment Program (SCSEP) provides part-time On-the-Job training/working opportunities in Community Service activities for unemployed, low-income persons aged 55 or older who have poor employment prospects, and assists these older persons in transitioning to unsubsidized employment.
