### Staffing Services

- **Candidate Screening, Referrals and Retention Services**

The San Francisco workforce development system actively recruits and trains thousands of local residents every year, preparing them to enter or re-enter the workforce with the most up-to-date skills to benefit local companies across industry sectors. Business Services Specialists can provide you with access to qualified applicants who have been pre-screened for the skills and job duties that you require, including employee retention services.

- **Job Distribution Services**

Employers can direct their employment opportunities to a single point of contact and have their jobs shared across a robust city-wide employment distribution network of community based organizations and workforce service providers.

- **No-Cost Recruitment Facilities**

Access Points are available to local employers for use in conducting onsite recruitment and interviewing events. Put this public space to work for you!

### Employee Training Services

- **On-The-Job Subsidized Training**

Business Services can work with you to find candidates who are eligible for up to a 50% salary reimbursement when on-the-job training is provided.

- **Layoff and Outplacement Services**

In the event of a layoff, free outplacement services can be provided through Rapid Response to help affected employees connect with unemployment insurance, healthcare resources, and job transition services such as job counseling, training opportunities, and placement assistance. Rapid Response services were designed to complement State and Federal WARN Act requirements. Faster transitions to new employment can potentially minimize the length of unemployment insurance claims.
