Goodwill Workshops

Employer Hiring Events: Attend frequently scheduled employer events to get direct access to employers and learn about the companies and job opportunities they offer. You will have an opportunity to ask any and all of your questions. Often, employers will be conducting on-the-spot job interviews. Bring your resume and look sharp.

Partner Services

Human Services Agency (HSA): Receive information about financial assistance, food, and housing support, and employment and training opportunities.

Disability Employment Initiative (DEI/Resume ToolWorks) Orientation: Education, training and employment opportunities for adults with disabilities.

City College Orientation: Representatives on-site to answer questions regarding Admissions, Programs, Finances, and other Support Services.

Five Keys Charter School: Provides educational programs and services including: high school diploma, GED, ESL, and college access to transitional youth and adults.
