Young Adult Subsidized Employment Program

Already have experience from an internship or previous work? Get the additional support and training you need in order to become successfully employed in high-demand industries such as hospitality, healthcare, technology and construction.

What this program offers:

- Transitional job experience
- Career coaching, and customized work plan
- Basic financial literacy training
- Personal development and case management
- Guidance on required documentation and paperwork needed for employment
- Job placement and guaranteed 12 months of follow-up support after employment

Minimum Qualifications:

- Must be between 17-24 years old
- San Francisco resident
- Willing to take drug test

Minimum Eligibility:

- Must be between 17-24 years old
- San Francisco residency preferred
- Able to communicate in English
- Willing to take drug test (results do NOT affect eligibility)
