Young Adult Subsidized Employment Program

Already have experience from an internship or previous work? Are you looking to gain valuable work-experience and earn while you learn?

Get the additional support and training you need in order to become successfully employed in high-demand industries such as hospitality, healthcare, technology, construction, and more...

What this program offers:

- Paid work experience
- Career coaching, and customized work plan
- Basic financial literacy training
- Personal development and case management
- Guidance on required documentation and paperwork needed for employment
- Job placement and guaranteed 12 months of follow-up support after employment

- Must be between 17-24 years old
- San Francisco residency preferred
