The "San Francisco Substandard Income Criteria" reflect, for each size of family, the larger of two federally specified income criteria. These two criteria are the "Official (Nationwide Urban) Poverty Level" computed, revised, and published annually by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) in the Federal Register on January 18, 2018 and the 2018 seventy percent of the "Lower Living Standard Income Level" (LLSIL) for the San Francisco Metropolitan Statistical Area computed, revised, and published by the Secretary of Labor in the Federal Register on May 29, 2018.

Maximum income amount for each size of family for the period (6 months) immediately preceding the date of application which is applicable for purposes of determining eligibility for WIOA Title I programs.

(\*)Add \$3,379 for each additional family member over 6.
