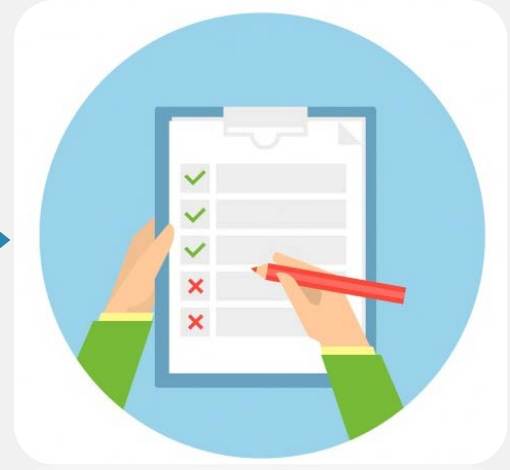
# Program Highlights
